

9 August 1862. Saturday. Attended Committee at Norwich Castle. On Thursday Aug 7 Parliament prorogued. Rolfe bought 100 wethers for me (shearlings) 34/6.

13 August 1862. Wednesday. Weighed the 'family'

16 August 1862. Saturday. The 15th anniversary of my wedding day. Gave dear Flo a pair of enamelled earrings.

18 August 1862. Monday. To Union Workhouse.

19 August 1862. Tuesday. To Wymm. Petty Sessions. Very little business. Bought 50 half bred ewes from Rolfe. Saw 'Rosa's' comet.

20 August 1862. Wednesday. Began harvest—barley. Mlle. went away for a holiday.

28 August 1862. Thursday. Went to Letton to luncheon. Met there Sir G. Nugent¹³² &c. On Monday-at the Union House, the Parochial Asst. Act adopted unanimously on my proposal, William Robert Cann (of Carick) seconding. Requested George Forrester to suggest to Mr. Robert James Tunaley not to persevere in being candidate for appt. of medical officer, as could not support him after his forced resignation of that office some 14 years ago. F. since told me that Tunaley has withdrawn.

29 August 1862. Friday. Target shooting at 200, 3 shots, 5 points, 3 hits; at 500, 7 shots. 3. 3 hits (all at 3rd class target).

1 September 1862. Monday. At Union Bd. resolution on Par: Asst. Act confirmed unanimously & David Watkins Hughes elected parish doctor viz Lewis dead. Tunaley who announced himself a candidate resigned
